**Romans 8** <sup>33</sup> Can the devil or anyone else accuse us of being God's enemies when God has already said we're His best friends? Nope, no one, nada, zip. God said you're His best friend, that's it... cuz He sez so.

#### Proof from His Word: John 8:3-11

The enemy's attacks bounce off of us!

**Romans 8** <sup>35</sup> Can anything separate us from the love Jesus has for us? Can troubles or problems or sufferings? If we have no food or clothes, if we are in danger, or even if we die--can any of these things separate us from Jesus' love?

<sup>37</sup> But in all these things we are **SURE WINNERS** through Jesus who showed His love for us.

## Proof from His Word:

**Exodus 15:11** Who is like Thee among the gods, O LORD? Who is like Thee, majestic in HOLINESS awesome in praises, working wonders?

**1 Samuel 6:20** Who is able to stand before the Lord, this HOLY God? And to whom shall He go up from us.

**Psalms 99:9** Exalt the Lord our God, and worship at His HOLY hill; for HOLY is the Lord our God.

**Isaiah 6:3** And one called out to another and said, "HOLY, HOLY, HOLY is the LORD of hosts, the whole earth is full of His glory."

**Revelation 15:4** "Who will not fear, O Lord, and glorify Thy name? For Thou alone art HOLY; for all the nations will come and worship before Thee, for Thy righteous acts have been revealed."

## Perfect creation

## Isaiah 6

<sup>1</sup> In the year King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord. He was sitting on a lofty throne, and the train of his robe filled the Temple. <sup>2</sup> Hovering around him were mighty seraphim, each with six wings. With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with the remaining two they flew. <sup>3</sup> In a great chorus they sang, "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty!
