

1. Biblical Theology – Whole Bible - Things develop
 - a. #1 Rule of Biblical interpretation
 - i. Move from clear to unclear (Revelation unclear)
 - b. Temple – Translation “House of God”
 - i. Eden – God present on Hill waters flow from
 - ii. Jacob’s Ladder – stone – House of God
 - iii. Tent in Desert
 - iv. Solomon’s Temple
 - v. Rebuilt Temple by Cyrus 2 Chron 36:23
 - vi. Jesus = god’s dwelling – Jn 1:14, Coll 1:19
 - vii. Church – 1 Cor 3:16
 - viii. You – 1 Cor 6:19
 - c. Each is obsolete and disappears

2. Land theme develops like the Temple
 - a. OT Land 1271 - NT 37
 - b. Jesus changes land of Ps 37:11 to Earth in Mt 5:5
 - c. Paul
 - i. Chooses “world” rather than land Rom 4:13
 - ii. Denigrates Jerusalem by calling her Hagar in Gal 4:25-26
 - d. Jesus
 - i. John 2:19-20 Destroy Temple I will raise in 3 days
 - ii. Prophecies Fall of Jerusalem & Temple Mt 24:2, Mk 13:2, Lk 19:44
 1. Sign of Jesus being a true prophet AD 70
 - iii. Never refers to it being rebuilt
 1. Rather He weeps over Jerusalem Lk 23:28
 - e. OT predicts temple rebuilding before it fell in 586

- f. Heb 8:9-12 & “13” Old covenant obsolete “law in mind & heart”
- g. Equivalent terms for Land in NT (Canonical Thematic Theology)
 - i. Jerusalem (Rabbis = center of earth/universe)
 - ii. Temple
 - iii. How does NT handle these terms
 - 1. Jerusalem – destroyed
 - 2. After Resurrection – Jesus launches kingdom from Galilee not Jer
 - a. Mt 28:16-20 on mountain launches Kingdom
 - i. This is a put down of Jerusalem
 - 3. Luke’s last parable before Jerusalem is 10 Minus
 - a. Clearly rejecting leaders & Jerusalem
 - b. Giving kingdom to Church
 - c. Kill those that reject
 - 4. Acts
 - a. Escape Jerusalem Acts 8:1
 - b. Church center becomes Antioch Acts 10-13
 - c. Acts ends in Rome with Paul teaching
 - i. Jerusalem is not the end – subverts Jewish view
