## INTRODUCTION

Key Point:

Worship isn't primarily about getting something for yourself, it is primarily about giving everything to God!

Romans 1:25 (NASB)

For they exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and **worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator**, who is blessed forever.

Four Key Truths:

When Moses came down from Mount Sinai with the two tablets of the Testimony in his hands, he was not aware that **his face was radiant** because he had spoken with the Lord ...33 When Moses finished speaking to them, he **put a veil over his face**.

2 Corinthians 3:13

We are not like Moses, who would put a veil over his face to **keep the Israelites from gazing at it while the radiance was fading away**.

If **Your Presence** does not go with us, do not send us up from here.
